Give us Your Feedback!

It's that time of year again! Each year we get students and parents of students in Grades 4, 5, and 6 to complete the "Accountability Pillar Survey". Though the name isn't catchy, and may be somewhat confusing, the purpose of this survey is to get feedback from students and parents on the culture, safety and learning environment of Breton Elementary.

Students in Grade 4, 5, and 6 are assigned a random username and password so that survey responses cannot be attributed to any individual student. Students will be **surveyed before the end of February**. The survey **takes about 10 minutes** to complete on-line and will be done within the school day during regular class time.

Parents of students in Grades 4, 5, and 6 will also have been sent a survey and **we would really appreciate it if parents could take the time to complete and submit the survey** so we can get a more accurate and current idea of parent perception of our school and how well it serves our young people.

The data gathered from the survey will be used for our school's **Education Plan** and the data should be available by the spring 2018.

100 Day is usually just celebrated by students in Grades 1—2, and they get to have fun in the gym exploring the number 100 and showing their understanding.


But this year **ALL** students (and staff) get to have fun with 100 Day by dressing up to **show** what they might look like if they were 100 years old!
