Thanks to the support and generosity of our community, PAC has had a very successful fundraising year so far. Here is a breakdown of what some of the funds are being used for this year:

- **New school t-shirts** for all students and staff—approximately \$2500
- Large **message board sign in front of the school** approximately \$11,000.

Report Cards and Student-Led Conferences

This time of year is busy with students and teachers preparing and assessing for the upcoming report card. **Report cards** will go home with students on **Thursday, March 26**.

To follow up with the report card, we are **hosting student-led confer**ences on Tuesday, March 31, and Wednesday, April 1.

Some of the larger classes (grades 1, 3, 5 and 6) will also be having student led conferences on **Thursday, April 2** in order to accommodate the large numbers of conferences they need to schedule.

Student-led conferences allow students the opportunity to personally share their Leadership Notebook with parents, not only discussing their academic progress and goals, but also showing off the ways they show leadership in the classroom and around the school.

In **some** classrooms there will be **centers set up** around the room where students can take their parents and **demonstrate skills and concepts** they've learned.

Teachers are still present at the conference and are able to address any concerns or provide greater understanding of student progress if needed.

A **sign-up sheet will be sent home later this month** for parents to indicate which time best suits them for their child's conference.

We hope that you will be able to make an appointment for studentled conferences and give your child the opportunity to share their learning and growth with you in their own voice. It is a **powerful opportunity for reflection and celebration** that will help empower students in their academic and personal growth for term 3.
