

## Breton Elementary Grade 6 Supply List

This is a list of the supplies your child will most likely need in Grade 6.

\*\*Seeing as the new Grade 6 teacher doesn't start until fall, we don't have his list. We created this list as a general guideline based on what Mrs. Feist and Mr. Peppler used over the last years. We begin using and organizing the supplies right away on the first day, **so please send all of these items with your child on the first day of school**, if possible.

\*\*The school is also open the week before school starts, so you can drop off your child's supplies early to prevent such a heavy load on the first day.

Extra supplies that are not used right away will be stored in the classroom until they are needed. **Feel free to recycle items from last year** if they are still in good condition!

- **30 pencils** – yes...they will need them all! ☺
- **1 hand-held pencil sharpener** (sometimes our electric sharpeners break down)
- **2 red pens**
- **3 highlighters (yellow)**
- 1 package of 24 **pencil crayons** (Laurentian are best)
- 1 package of **thick-tipped felt markers** (like Mr. Sketch)
- **5 erasers**
- **2 core subject binders** – (**1½ inches** each) – **NO ZIP UP BINDERS! THEY ARE TOO BIG TO FIT IN DESKS!**
- **1 Leadership Notebook binder** (2 inches thick) – if you have the binder from last year use it... also not needed first day)
- 1 package of **white copy paper**
- **12 dividers/tabs** (for the binders and Leadership Notebook)
- 2 pairs of **scissors** (stainless steel blade – Fiskars are best)
- **4 glue sticks**
- 1 bottle of **white glue** (for interactive notebooks and art projects – it sticks longer)
- 1 metric ruler (**30 cm**) with millimeters and inches – **no flexible rulers!**
- **10 duotangs** – **no flimsy plastic ones** please!
- 1 **protractor** (they can be bought separately at the dollar store...**no need for a full geometry set**)
- 1 **calculator** (**cheap is fine**...larger buttons and display are better)
- **10 white board dry erase pens** (black or dark colors, please) – believe me, they'll go through all 10!
- 1 pair **headphones** (for Chromebooks or listening centers)
- 1 wireless computer **mouse** (for use with Chromebooks)
- 1 pair of white-soled **indoor shoes**
- 2 **boxes of Kleenex** (not needed first day)
- 1 bottle of **hand sanitizer** (something that can fit in a desk please)

\*\*We haven't been using much lined paper in the past couple of years, so do not send any. The school has plenty that we can supply should we need it.

### **PLEASE PUT YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON ALL THEIR SUPPLIES!**

That includes each crayon, marker, glue stick, etc. Sharpie markers work very well for this. It really helps lost items get returned to their owner.
